

Public minutes from
2nd Consortium meeting

IMA 6 month review meeting was held in Melton Mowbray on 12th April 2013 and was hosted by ISRI. Sixteen people attended the meeting.

The product requirement specification undertaken in Work Package 1 was shared with all the partners, which included the results from physiotherapist focus group meetings held in Valencia and Reykjavik. These have been documented in deliverable reports.

The next part of the technical meeting concentrated on the development of the sensors, both the system configuration and measurement system. Discussions took place regarding the different alternatives in real time visualizing IMA measurement as the focus groups requested biofeedback. It was concluded that we should head for a simple graphical visualization of results.

Following technical discussion there was a meeting session concerning dissemination and exploitation activities, the need to provide the general public with updates on the progress of the project utilizing the project website and maybe social media.

Project plan was reviewed; project objectives are very much in line with physiotherapists' requests and no technical barriers foreseen. It was decided to keep on as planned.

The next IMA meetings were discussed and decided to have a technical meeting in Reykjavik in May and the full management meeting being held in Valencia Sept/Oct. The dates still have to be arranged.

The meeting was closed at 14:30 by Páll Árnason and he thanked all the participants for their input in the meeting.
